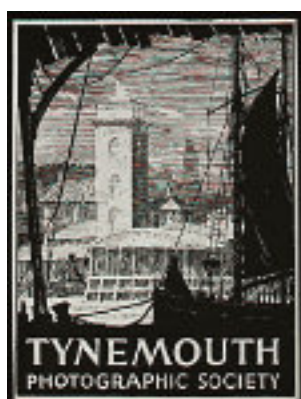


A NEW PUBLICATION
